- Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) or equivalent education recognized by the MARRT
 - Registration with MARRT required; Bachelor's Degree in Respiratory Therapy preferred
 - BCLS Certification, Asthma Educator and/or COPD Educator an asset
 - Current registration/membership in the Canadian Society of Respiratory Therapists (CSRT) is required or an equivalent professional organization, as determined by the employer, for therapists not eligible for CSRT registration
 - Ability to lift heavy medical equipment including measuring devices, monitors, D and E sized gas cylinders and other equipment weighing up to 15 lbs.
 - Ability to move H and M sized gas cylinders weighing 66 - 100 lbs.
